Please bring the following supplies on Kindergarten Orientation Day (September 3 or 4).

For your convenience, you have the option to purchase your “Classroom Supplies” online through 1st Day School Supplies using the link on our website. These supplies will be shipped to Albertville Primary and you may pick up your supply kit on Orientation Day (September 3 or 4). The cost of the supply kit is \$39.99. The deadline to order your supply kit is June 30, 2019. The “Other Supplies” are not included in the supply kit. Look for this logo on our website for the link to order:



Classroom Supplies:

- 2 plastic pocket folders with prongs (not a 3-ring binder) ← 
- 5” **Fiskars** child scissors (the metal kind work best)
- 1 rectangular cloth pencil pouch with zipper (approx. 7.38” x 10”) ←  (pouch with grommets)
- 1 box of regular **Crayola** markers (classic colors)
- 3 boxes of **Crayola** crayons (24-count)
- 12 small **Elmer’s** glue sticks (0.21 fl oz)
- 12 wooden yellow #2 pencils (sharpened)
- 1 large pink eraser
- 1 black composition notebook (wide ruled)
- 1 spiral notebook (wide-ruled, plain color cover)
- 1 box of 200 count Kleenex
- 4 low odor **Expo** dry erase **black** markers

Purchase below based on last name:

- Last Name A-L: 1 box of storage bags 50 count (quart size) and 1 container of Clorox wipes
- Last Name M-Z: 1 box of storage bags 50 count (gallon size) and 1 container of **unscented** baby wipes

Other Supplies:

- 1 large school bag (no wheels)
- Paint t-shirt for Art – oversized t-shirt with **NO** buttons with first name written on the front in permanent marker
- A pair of gym shoes for Phy Ed/SMART Room –
Velcro or elastic shoes, if your child can’t tie his/her own shoes yet.
(Note: These can be the same shoes your child wears to school each day, they do not need a separate pair to stay at school.)



Please Note:

- **Please do not write** your child’s name on any of the “Classroom Supplies” items.
- Sometimes a larger quantity of items is less expensive than the smaller quantity and it is perfectly fine to purchase more. For example, the pack of 24 pencils is often less expensive than the price of the pack of 12.
- Teachers may request additional classroom supplies during the year.
